

Freedom of Association

Action plan

Addressing the topic of freedom of association is a key element of our human rights strategy to provide protection against discrimination or even harassment. For this purpose, we have committed to publish an action plan with time-bound measures to promote freedom of association:

- 1. We include freedom of association as a requirement for suppliers in our code of conduct and sustainable purchasing practice. (Until End of 2023)
- 2. Participation in MSI's to support actively collective bargaining (Until End of 20232)
- Consultation with unions to understand Obstacles of the freedom of association with a special focus on barriers faced by women. (Until End of 20232)
- 4. We educate our suppliers in high-risk supply chains on the topic of freedom of association. (Until End of 2024)
- 5. We implement trainings in consultation of unions and local stakeholders in three high risk supply chains for workers in order to educate workers regarding their right of association with a special focus on barriers faced by women. (Until End of 2024)
